LICENSING (ACTIVITIES) SUB-COMMITTEE

LICENSING ACT 2003 APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE RED LION, 2 MARKET PLACE, EPWORTH, DN9 1EU

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To request that the Sub-Committee determines the application for Variation of a Premises Licence for Red Lion, Epworth.
- 1.2 There have been 5 representations, which have been deemed relevant. These are detailed in paragraph 4.2. and are attached to this report as Appendices C, D, E, F and G.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 In accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 and the council's scheme of delegation, all applications for a licence where a relevant representation has been made need to be determined by this Sub-Committee.
- 2.2 When determining the application, the Sub-Committee should only consider issues, which relate to the four licensing objectives. The licensing objectives are:
 - The prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Public Safety
 - The prevention of a Public Nuisance
 - The protection of Children from Harm
- 2.3 Members of the Sub-Committee must have regard to the statutory guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 and our Statement of Licensing Policy. Members of the Sub-Committee may deviate from the statutory guidance and licensing policy only if they deem that there is good reason to do so.
- 2.4 Members of the Sub-Committee should not allow themselves to predetermine the application or to be prejudiced in favour or opposed to the licence and shall only determine the application having had an opportunity to consider all relevant facts. Members of the Sub-Committee should not hear or decide on any applications for premises licences in their own ward.

- 2.5 Members of the Sub-Committee shall remember that they are acting in a quasi-judicial role in determining the application and shall remain in the room so that they hear all the evidence before determining the application. The determination shall be based on the evidence provided which is relevant to the licensing objectives.
- 2.6 The options available to the Licensing (Activities) Sub-Committee having considered all the relevant information are as follows:
 - To modify the conditions of the licence;
 - To reject the whole or part of the application
- 2.7 Members of the Sub-Committee should be advised that the applicant, statutory consultees and persons making relevant representations may appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of the date on which they were notified of the decision.

3. **ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION**

3.1 The application for the variation of a premises licence for the Red Lion was received on 28 September 2012. A copy of the application is attached to the report at Appendix A. The nature of the variation application is as follows:

Variation	Detail
Additional Activities	Films, indoor sporting events, performance of dance and dancing to the licensable hours currently permitted for regulated entertainment.
	Also to add late night refreshment to the licence to enable the sale of tea, coffee, etc
Change of Hours	None
Remove Conditions	Live Music and Recorded Music shall only take place at pre-arranged functions. There will be at least 10 working days notice to the police and the licensing authority for each function. The functions will be of a similar nature to weddings, anniversaries and birthday parties. The public will not have access to the functions
Add Conditions	To allow functions to take place on the premises without any restrictions

3.2 The premises currently holds a Premises Licence, determined on 7 September 2005. A copy of the current Premises Licence is attached to this report at Appendix B.

- 3.3 There have been 5 letters of objection from interested parties, which have been deemed relevant. These are detailed in paragraph 4.2 and are attached to this report as Appendix C,D,E, F and G.
- 3.3 The applicant's solicitor has been made aware of the representations

- 4.1 An applicant wishing to vary a Premises Licence has to serve a copy of the application form and a plan of the premises on the statutory consultees the same day as the Licensing Authority receives its copy.
