**LICENSING (ACTIVITIES) SUB-COMMITTEE**

The meeting was held in Room G01e/G02e, Church Square House, Scunthorpe.

2121 **APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN - Resolved** – That Councillor K Vickers be and he was hereby appointed Chairman for the meeting.

2122 **DECLARATIONS OF DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS, PERSONAL OR PERSONAL AND PREJUDICIAL INTERESTS, AND SIGNIFICANT CONTACT WITH APPLICANTS, OBJECTORS OR THIRD PARTIES (LOBBYING), IF ANY** - There were no declarations of disclosable pecuniary interests, Personal or personal and prejudicial interests, or significant contact with applicants, objectors or third parties (lobbying).

2123 **APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE AT THE MARY ROSE, 64 FRODINGHAM ROAD, SCUNTHORPE, DN15 7JN** - The Director: Communities submitted a report that advised of an application for the review of a premises licence at the Mary Rose, 64 Frodingham Road, Scunthorpe.

Details of the review application were outlined in the report, together with representations submitted by Humberside Police.

The Director in their report reminded the sub-committee that the options available to it under the Licensing Act 2003 when considering such applications were:

- To modify the conditions of the licence
- To exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
- To remove the designated premises supervisor
- To suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
- To revoke the licence

Prior to the consideration of the review application, the Licensing (Activities) Sub Committee received a request from Humberside Police legal representative to adjourn the hearing due to the late circulation of the supporting documentation submitted by the respondent. The Licence Holder's Legal Representative agreed to the adjournment and in doing so confirmed that the premises would remain closed until a conclusion of this review hearing.

The sub-committee agreed to a short adjournment to discuss the request.

**Resolved** – (a) That the hearing be adjourned, and reconvened at 10.00 am

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on 17 October 2024, and (b) that the Sub Committee as part of this decision considered paragraph 12 of the 182 Licensing Act Guidance and agreed to deviate from the guidance subject to the Licence Holder providing a written undertaking to confirm that the premises would remain closed. In addition, the suspension of the premises licence would be extended until the determination of the full review of the Premises Licence on the 17 October 2024.
