- 2.3 The Food Standards Agency Code of Practice sets out the expected levels of interventions to be carried out at different premises. However over recent years there has been a greater focus on targeted enforcement. Therefore more consideration is now given to other methods of interventions rather than traditional routine inspections. The plans reflect this with fewer routine inspections planned than in previous years.
- 2.4 The other principles of the plans have not changed from previous years.

- 3.1 **Option 1** To approve the revised Food, Feed and Health & Safety Service Plans.
- 3.2 **Option 2** To continue with the existing Food, Feed and Health & Safety Service Plans.
