Both cut ends of the belt are attached to an ornate metal buckle. The original record suggests the metal is silver but it is more likely to be silver plated brass. There are areas where the brass is visible through the silvering. The centre of the ornate 'Gothic style' emblems forming the belt is a 'St Michael' [Sanctus Michael Archangelus] medallion made by L Chalin. It has a raised figure of an angel spearing a reclining body and on the reverse is a coat of arms and motto. The medallion covers the point where each half of the belt interlocks to fasten it.
