REVOCATION AND AMENDMENT OF TRUNK ROAD CLEARWAY ORDER

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To consider objections received to the above Traffic Regulation Order (TRO).
- 1.2 The key points in this report are as follows:
 - Revocation of sections of the A18 Clearway were proposed.
 - An objection has been received on safety grounds to part of the order

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 Officers proposed to remove various lengths of clearway within North Lincolnshire to remove sign clutter at several junctions.
- 2.2 Officers from Humberside Police and our Road Safety Team Site carried out site visits. At this time no concerns were raised
- 2.3 The proposed restrictions are shown in appendix 1.

THE NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL (THE VARIOUS TRUNK ROADS (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (CLEARWAYS) ORDER 1963 (REVOCATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that North Lincolnshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 39(6), 50(6) and 59(6) of Paragraph 27, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to revoke and amend the prohibition of waiting on main carriageways Order specified in the Schedule to the extent therein described. A copy of the draft Order, together with a statement of reasons and a plan showing the lengths of road affected can be seen at the Local Link Offices of Brigg and Scunthorpe and the Council Offices at Billet Lane, Normanby Enterprise Park, Scunthorpe DN15 9YH during normal office hours. Objections to the proposal specifying the grounds on which they are made should be sent in writing to the Director of Places at the Billet Lane address not later than 22nd June 2017.

SCHEDULE Revocation and Amendment

The Various Trunk Roads (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1963 (Statutory Instrument No 1172) in so far as it relates to the Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) and those main carriageways in those lengths of trunk roads that lie within the County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey or Borough of Scunthorpe:

Section 123 – revoke the entire Section which currently reads between the West Riding of Yorkshire County Boundary 700 yards west of its junction with Jacques Bank Road and a point 230 yards south of its junction with Station Road (B1392) Keadby, a distance of approximately 6.25 miles

Section 125 – amend this Section to read between a point 10 yards east of its junction with Brigg Road (A1029) Scunthorpe and a point 10 yards west of Briggate Lodge Roundabout, a distance of approximately 2.75 miles

Section 126 – revoke the entire Section which currently reads between a point 350 yards west of Wrawby Railway Bridge and a point 190 yards west of its junction with the Class III Road leading to Bigby, a distance of approximately 2.5 miles

Section 127 – amend this Section to read between a point 10 yards east of its junction with the Class 2 Road leading to Croxton (B1211) and a point 450 yards west of its junction with the Class 3 Roads leading to Grasby and Swallow at Great Limber, a distance of approximately 4 miles
