1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To consider the objection received to the proposed Various Roads TRO for Bottesford, Brigg and Scunthorpe.
- 1.2 The key points in this report are as follows:
 - The proposed measures will address safety concerns for the areas in Bottesford, Brigg and Scunthorpe.
 - The proposed measures will improve the regulation of parking within the areas concerned.
 - The objectors are asking for different parking restrictions along Aston Square/ Highcliff Gardens and Manor Farm Road, than what is proposed.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 The planned TRO is part of efforts to reduce the number vehicles parking within areas of Bottesford, Brigg and Scunthorpe.
- 2.2 Various issues have been reported at these locations.

3. OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 Option 1 To approve the traffic regulation order (TRO) and introduce the parking restrictions.
- 3.2 Option 2 To uphold the objections and not introduce any parking restrictions.

3.3 To re-advertise the order and suggest different parking restrictions for the areas of De Aston Square/ Highcliff Gardens and Manor Farm Road.

4. ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

- 4.1 Option 1 This is the preferred option. It will allow the council to apply the TRO.
- 4.2 Option 2 This will not help to reduce the number of vehicles parking or stop inconsiderate parking.
- 4.3 Option 3 This would result in more consultation and extend the legal process.

5. RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS (FINANCIAL, STAFFING, PROPERTY, IT)

- 5.1 The cost of re-advertising the order is £1000, whilst staffing costs would come from within the council.
- 5.2 There are no staffing, property or IT issues related with this report.

6. OUTCOMES OF INTEGRATED IMPACT ASSESSMENT (IF APPLICABLE)

6.1 Officers have carried out an integrated impact assessment. There were no major issues found.

7. OUTCOMES OF CONSULTATION AND CONFLICTS OF INTERESTS DECLARED

- 7.1 The consultation with the Ward members and statutory bodies has been carried out. A Copy of the objection is attached in Appendix 2.
- 7.2 The council has had 2 objections. The first objection is for the area of Aston Square/ Highcliff Gardens. The objector thinks that double yellow lines on Aston Square should go all the way round. If this cannot be done the other options, that the objector suggested, is for parking bays either side of (28) Highcliff Gardens or extend the double yellow lines across the driveway to (28) Highcliff Gardens.
- 7.3 The second objection is for the Manor Farm Road area. The objector feels that the proposed restrictions would make it difficult for them to access their drive from one direction. They would like the double yellow lines extending to level with the front door of number 8 Manor Farm Road.

8. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 8.1 That the Cabinet Member approves the Traffic Regulation Order, as shown on the plan in Appendix 2.
- 8.2 That officers' write to the objectors advising them of the decision, following the normal legal procedure.

Doncaster Road, Scunthorpe – extending by 3m at each end the existing No Stopping on Entrance Markings Mon-Fri, 8am-5pm outside St Lawrence Academy - DR/SLA/TRO/001Rev A

Dudley Road, Brigg – additional No Waiting at Any Time restriction near the junction of Barnard Avenue - DR/TRO/001 REV A

Forrester Street, Brigg - revoking the No Waiting at Any Time restriction outside the new houses - FS/TRO/001

Messingham Road, Bottesford - Layby outside the Visitors Centre - introducing a restriction of parking 3 hours no return 2 hours 9am-6pm - MR/TRO/001

Manor Farm Road, Scunthorpe – amending the No Waiting at Any Time restriction near its junction with Priory Lane - MFR/TRO/001

Willoughby Road, Scunthorpe – extending the existing No Waiting at Any Time restriction near its junction with Messingham Road - WR/TRO/GR/2018/001
