# **Additional Restrictions Grant - Covid-19 Discretionary Grants**

#### 1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To approve the recommendations made by the Head of Service for the Additional Restrictions Grant Covid-19 Discretionary Grants.
- 1.2 The decision is urgent to be able to advise companies on the outcome of their grant application and to progress with their scheme.

#### 2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 North Lincolnshire Council is in receipt of Additional Restrictions Grant (ARG) monies which have been made available to support businesses that have been disrupted during the Covid-19 pandemic.
- 2.2 Three new discretionary grant schemes were launched to support affected businesses either to start up or invest to diversify or grow. The three schemes are:
  - Business Start-Up Grant
  - Covid-19 Renew Fund
  - Business Diversification Grant
- 2.3 Each grant scheme has a specific focus. The start up grant is designed to help individuals who have decided to start up a new business following either a change in circumstances or being made redundant. The Covid-19 Renew Fund is to support businesses that are looking to invest to grow. The Business Diversification Grant supports businesses that are looking to diversify their offer to improve the long term viability of their business.
- 2.4 The schemes have been established following an existing framework to ensure transparency, accountability and assurance.
- 2.5 The Start-up grants are low scale funds (not exceeding £1,000) and delegated approval is in place to process these quickly using the

framework in place. Details of those approved through delegated decisions are provided in section 3 below.

- 4.3 Option 2 If the grant recommendations are not approved the ARG monies will remain unspent and North Lincolnshire businesses will not benefit from this support fund.
