SAFER, STRONGER COMMUNITIES – RURAL CABINET MEMBER

COMMUNITY GRANT APPLICATIONS HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS 2022

1. OBJECT AND KEY POINTS IN THIS REPORT

- 1.1 To consider applications for financial support against the eligibility criteria of the scheme and available funds.
- 1.2 To confirm the level of community grant support to be awarded as outlined in Appendix 1.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 In June 2022 the Nation will come together over a four-day Bank Holiday weekend to celebrate the Queen's 70-year reign – the first time any British monarch has reached this milestone.
- 2.2 The council will enable a range of community-led activities and events over the long weekend for communities to mark this historic occasion.
- 2.3 The Cabinet Member for Safer, Stronger Communities – Rural has previously agreed the terms of the scheme and allocated funding to support communities across North Lincolnshire to organise and join in the celebrations (Minute 8 - November 2021).
- 2.4 Applications have now been received from a broad range of community organisations and assessed against the published criteria. Details of the applications recommended together with the amount of financial support requested are set out in Appendix 1.

Option 1

- 3.2 Do not approve the amounts requested or vary the proportion of grant awarded.

4. ANALYSIS OF OPTIONS

4.1 The applications included in Appendix 1 meet the required eligibility criteria for grant funding.

Financial

5.1 Funding of up to £250 per applicant was resolved as part of the criteria set for the scheme in November 2021.

5.2 The total cost of applications received is as follows:
